BIG IDEA: It is when believers feel most **self-sufficient** that they are in the most desperate need of a humble and passionate **reconnection** with the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

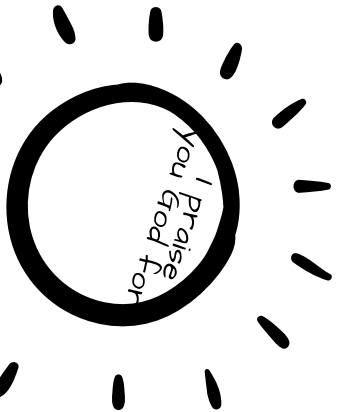
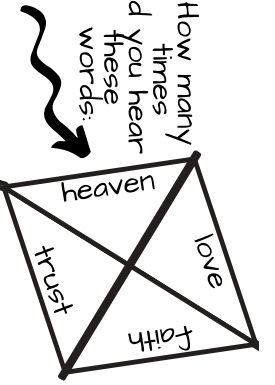
- For those who encountered Jesus during His ministry, one of three actions occurred: hatred, terror, or adoration. There is no trace of people expressing mere **mild approval**. ~ C.S. Lewis
- Lukewarmness is the worst form of blasphemy because it means a believer is acting as if the Lord of the universe is not worthy of our most **passionate faith**.
- The love and grace of Christ always sees His children for who they **really are** and not for what they attempt to convey to Him and others.
- In the Middle East, to be invited to eat with someone meant not only sharing a **meal** but also sharing a **life**.
- In light of all that has happened this past six months, maybe every church and believer in America should ask, "**Is that** knock for me?"

- List three thoughts or things in your life that honestly tempt you to feel self-sufficient from God and then pray for strength to submit them to His Lordship.
- Read the ancient hymn from Colossian 1:15-20 and allow the implications of that staggering truth to touch your soul with an eternal perspective. What thoughts about Christ come to mind?

- What are some of the recent events in your life that could be compared to "spiritual knocking sounds" Christ may be giving to get you to answer the door and seek His presence?
