**Big Idea:** Believers must live in hope because God is always purposely using us to build something more than we imagined.

## Big picture statements to help illustrate our position in Christ:

- 1) Believers are <u>citizens</u>. (vs. 19a)
- 2) Believers are a <u>family</u>. (vs. 19b)

- When we show tenacious love
- When we spend time with each other
- When we are real with one another
- When we serve together
- 3) Believers are a <u>home</u>. (vs. 20-22)
