### **Sermon Notes for Josh Imboden:**

- 1) Sometimes God may let us suffer or even let things die in our lives.
- 2) If you are in a relationship with Jesus, then there is no such thing as hopelessness.

### **Study/Application Questions and Actions:**

We always hear about how “Jesus brings life.” How would you explain what this means to someone who has never heard about Jesus before?

In your life, you will never fully understand why everything happens, and why God doesn't always show up in the way you'd expect. How does that make you feel? Can someone really have a strong faith in God even if they don't understand everything?

Read Philippians 4:12-13. Paul's famous quote of “I can do all things through Christ,” comes right after talking about facing difficulties. How can this apply to your lives?

Read Romans 8:35-37. If you are facing all kinds of struggles (like listed in verse 35), how can you still have victory (like verse 37 says)?

John 11:35, the shortest verse in the Bible, says “Jesus wept.” What does it mean for your life to know that we have a God who cares enough to weep over us?

What is the difference between trusting in what God can do and trusting in who He is? In your own life, which do you tend to put more trust in—what God can do or who He is?
