Sermon Title: *A Worthy Redeemer Arrives!*

1) Jesus is the only redeemer worthy of worship. (Luke 19:37 / Matthew 13:54-58)

- Worthy worship recognizes God's mighty works.
- Worthy worship recognizes Jesus is the Savior.
- Worthy worship recognizes the need to glorify God.
- Worthy worship recognizes that praise is not optional.

2) Jesus is the only redeemer worthy of our service. (John 13:1-5 / 1 Peter 3:18)

3) Jesus is the only redeemer worthy of being redeemer.

The cross should never be treated as "in the way" because the cross is always the only way to eternal hope.

Study/Application Questions and Actions

- 1) Think of an experience in which there was more going on behind the scenes than you first thought.
- 2) If I only think God is working when something good is happening to me, what might I be missing in the way He is working through trials?
- 3) Compare the "glory to God in the highest" statement at Jesus' birth and in the Triumphal Entry. What common messages are they declaring?
- 4) What are examples of how God has transformed your "spiritually dead heart" into a heart of praise for Him?
- 5) Do you ever feel like you have to "clean up" before inviting Jesus to forgive you? How can we find freedom from that?
- 6) How can I treat the cross of Jesus like "the only way" instead of treating it as if it's "in the way"?
