Big Idea: God’s gift of spiritual freedom through Christ is best used when it is turned into action with sacrificial **service for God’s glory.**

Directives for Applying Spiritual Freedom to my life:

1) Don’t use freedom to selfishly sin.

(Galatians 5:13a / 1 Peter 2:16 / Romans 13:14)

- Spiritual freedom does not mean the absence of constraints or moral absolutes, but rather the liberty to live safely with God’s purpose and joy.

2) Use Freedom to Serve Others.

(Galatians 5:13b-15 / 1 John 4:7-9 / 1 Corinthians 13: 4-6 / Matthew 22:36-40)

- The Law of “One Another” means that “serving each other” and “loving each other” are a **matched set.**
- Regardless of what you SAY you believe, your true God is the one you worship with **sacrificial service.**

CONCLUSION:

The future of our country is not dependent on finding another hero, but rather upon finding the Savior.
