**What does it mean to love learning, living and teaching God’s truth to one another?**

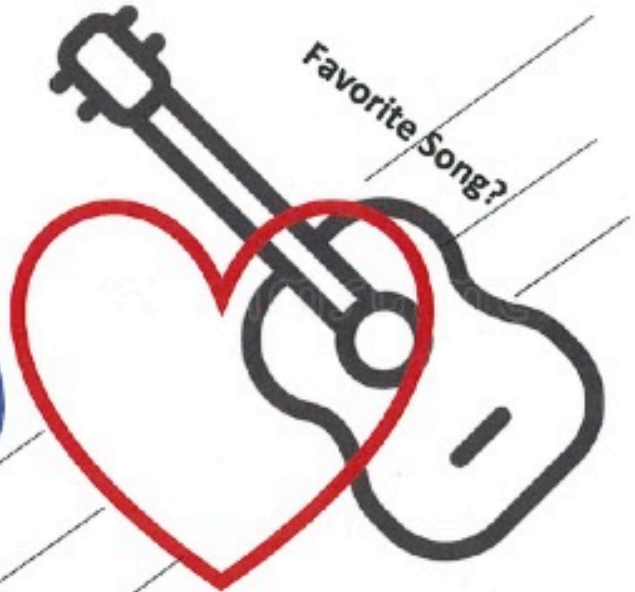
- 1) Loving to learn means being **Biblically practical**. (Colossians 3:16a)
- 2) Loving to learn means being **wisely practical**. (Colossians 3:16b & 1:15-20)
- 3) Loving to learn means being **universally practical**. (Colossians 3:17 / John 14:13-14)

- 1) What most motivates you to keep on learning even as you age?
- 2) What do you think it means that, *“learning to be godly is both taught and caught?”* How does this apply to your Bible reading?

- 4) Name some specific songs that have confirmed your faith throughout the years, or even some new songs that encourage your faith?
- 5) Think back on some recent conversations with others. If someone had been eavesdropping, would they have noticed Jesus Christ in that conversation? What can you do to make sure that is the case in the future?
