“A New ‘One Another’ We Must Learn to Love”

Big Idea: Successfully loving one another in a new way requires that we use the supernatural power of God’s presence to reflect His gospel into the world.

1) Foundational reasons for this new “one another”.

(Romans 13:8-9 / 1 Peter 1:22 / 1 John 3:10 / 1 John 3:23 / 1 John 4:7-12).

This new “one another” sums up the **10 commandments**.

This new “one another” is a supernatural **fruit** of salvation.

This new “one another” is a spiritual family **trait**.

This new “one another” is a **command**.

This new “one another” is a reasonable **response** to God’s love.

This new “one another” demonstrates God’s **existence**.

2) Foundational examples of this new “one another”.

How did Jesus model this “love one another”?

(Matthew 8:13 / Matthew 14 / / Matthew 19:22 / Mark 10 / Luke 19).

Jesus modeled a “**Leprosy** Love”.

Jesus modeled a “**Left-overs** Love”.

Jesus modeled a “**Truthful** Love”.

Jesus modeled a “**Blind** Love”.

Jesus modeled a “**Little-Guy** Love”.

Jesus modeled a “**Look-in-the-Mirror** Love”.

Jesus modeled a “**Stinky-feet** Love”.

Jesus modeled a “**Cross-my-Heart** Love”.

3) Foundational results of this new “one another”.

Place one another lovingly “**on your sleeves**” ...and then persevere.

Study/Application Questions and Actions:

- 1) What is the biggest reason you might struggle with loving other believers unconditionally? Think of a time when it was difficult.
- 2) Which of the Biblical “foundational reasons” for loving others do you personally find most motivating? Least motivating? Why?
- 3) Jesus perfectly practiced this new commandment. Which of his examples strikes a chord with you?
- 4) What personal spiritual disciplines might help you build “endurance” in loving others?
- 5) Name some other believers whom God may be motivating you to show love right now – and what specific action could you take to be loving?
